Curriculum Intent:

Our curriculum is designed to provide our children with an insight into the hair and beauty industry providing them with core knowledge and skills to develop the whole child. The curriculum has been sequenced so that powerful knowledge is built on unit by unit and learning is revisited to ensure it is secure before moving on. Students will develop confidence, communication skills and present a professional image in a workplace environment giving them key employability skills and preparing them for later life. They will experience education with character as they participate in real life situations including spiritual, moral, social and cultural development. They will develop their creativity and practical talents and showcase them to a range of individuals, participating in cultural capital events such as external competitions and college visits. Students see themselves in the curriculum and make choices on its direction, taking ownership of their learning. Students research a range of different careers in the industry from a beauty therapists to a dermatologists. They learn about these roles understanding all aspects from entry requirements to career paths and progression, giving students the essential knowledge they need to be a successful self- sufficient citizen.
