What will I learn?

There are 4 main areas of study:

- Two in-depth studies: Germany 1919-1939 and The Elizabethan Age 1588-1603

How will I be assessed?

There will be 4 final examinations in 2 x 2 hour exams.

USA topic = 20% (45 mins exam)
