- The Cold War.



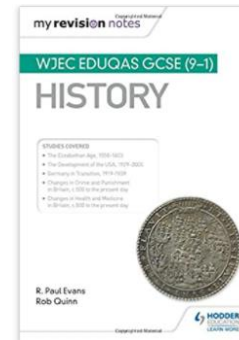
4) Changes in Health & Medicine in Britain
