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What will I learn?

During this course, you will study the main strands of Mathematics: Number, Proportion, Algebra, Geometry and Statistics.

Calculators will be used in most lessons and you will continue to be taught written and mental methods of calculation.

Pupils who have their own suitable calculator in lessons and at exams will be much better prepared.

How will I be assessed?

Students will complete 3 exams at the end of year 11. Together, these will make up their entire GCSE grade.

- Paper 3:** 33⅓% Calculator Allowed
