In Religious Studies, pupils will examine the six main world religions of Christianity, Islam, Judaism, Sikhism, Buddhism and Hindu Dharma. They will also investigate non-religious beliefs enabling them to reflect on and develop their own beliefs, values and attitudes. Students will engage with philosophical questions and their influence on human life, enabling them to develop analytical and critical thinking skills so they can present well-informed and reasonable arguments. This will contribute to their preparation for adult life in a pluralistic society and will aid them to be a respectful member of the global community.
