Dear Parent/Carer

On **Thursday 16th July** it is the Fir Vale Academy Sports Day. Sports Day is a normal school day in terms of attendance, therefore your child must attend school as normal. Students should arrive to school at the normal time of 8:30am and will be dismissed from school at 3:15pm. The Sports Day will take place at the Academy on the school field, Astro turf, MUGA and Basketball court.

Students will take part in a range of activities including; Athletics, Football and Basketball.

Kit: All students are expected to wear appropriate clothing for a school sports day. This should include:

- Black Fir Vale PE T-shirt
- Black tracksuit bottoms/shorts
- Black Trainers
- No jeans or sandals are allowed
- Students with long hair must have their hair tied up

Please note: you will need to send your child to school prepared for all weathers e.g. raincoat, sun cream, hat and sunglasses. Your child will take part in a variety of activities on the day; therefore, they should bring plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration.

Medical: Students who have a medical condition should be fully prepared and organised for the day. Any student who requires medication will need to bring this with them. If your child is asthmatic, it is important they remember their inhalers. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you wish to discuss any medical concerns you have about your child.

Phones and earphones: Please remember the school has a complete ban on phones and headphones (not seen, not heard). Any phones or earphones seen for any reason will be confiscated in line with the normal school policy. They must be switched off and at the bottom of their bags.

The school does not take any responsibility for any device that is damaged, broken or lost on the day. If your child chooses to bring a mobile phone or any other device, it is their responsibility to look after it in their own belongings. Please note: Students will not be allowed to take pictures/videos on the day. This is in line with the school's child protection policy.

We hope you will encourage your child to participate in your child's sports day. It is going to be a fantastic sporting experience for all students.
