Mock Exams

On the Thursday 6th November, the first set of Year 11 mock exams start. These will last until Thursday 27th November. The exam timetable is printed at the end of this letter. All students have a copy of the timetable and it is on display in their tutor room.

It is vital that these exams are taken seriously. Students have been spoken to about how important these mock exams are. We expect all students to prepare and revise well, show a positive attitude to the mock exams and behave correctly before, during and after each exam. We will be consistently communicating this message to all students and would appreciate if you could support this through your conversations at home.

Attendance over the mock examination period is crucial. Therefore, please could you make every effort to avoid making appointments or taking holidays during this period. It is also important that students are punctual to school and their exams.

Further, I would like to stress that all mock examinations are important, not just the core subjects (English, maths, science).

Booster Sessions

Booster sessions for the first exam of the day will be starting at 8:15am. Students need to arrive at school in time for the boosters, which will be led by an experienced member of staff and will contain vital exam tips and key content. Boosters for the exams starting at 11am or 1:30pm will be in school time. The exact details of these important sessions will be communicated to students in assembly.

Results Day

Your child will receive their results of their mock exams on Monday 8th December. Students then have 12 weeks to work on improving their grades at the next and final set of mock exams which begin on Monday 23rd February 2026.

Parents' Evening:

The first Parents' Evening for Y11 will be on Thursday 11th December 2025. The second Parents' Evening will be on Thursday 26th March 2026.

Additional support:

All Year 11 students have been given a pack of revision material to support them, containing postcards, post it notes, highlighters and other useful equipment.



They have also been given a booklet containing revision strategies and links for further information.
