A huge well done to all the students and a very, very proud Mrs Wood.

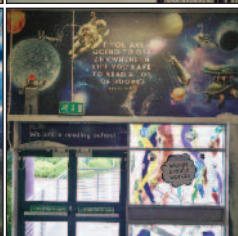
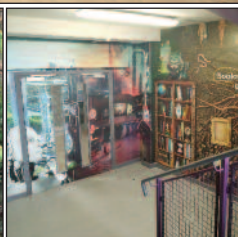


A Work of Art!
