Your child must also complete the homework tasks they were given on Wednesday (see below).



Which numbers have symmetry?	Split a page into 4 quarters by drawing a horizontal and vertical lines of symmetry through the middle. Draw a shape, pattern or picture with 2 lines of symmetry. You can use squared paper to make this easier. Colour your picture and bring it to your Maths teacher. English	Find the opening lines of a poem that really grabs your attention. It could be from a book or something on line. Try to write the next 4 lines of the poem in the same style.	Can you create a 'Found Poem'? This is made by cutting out words or lines from a magazine or newspaper and sticking them together to create a piece of poetry!	Find an image on the computer of a place that you know is representing a different culture. Try to write a poem based on the picture you have found (don't worry in it does not rhyme!)

Research your star sign and produce a diagram to show what it looks like in the sky. Design an infographic to show information about five different religions.
